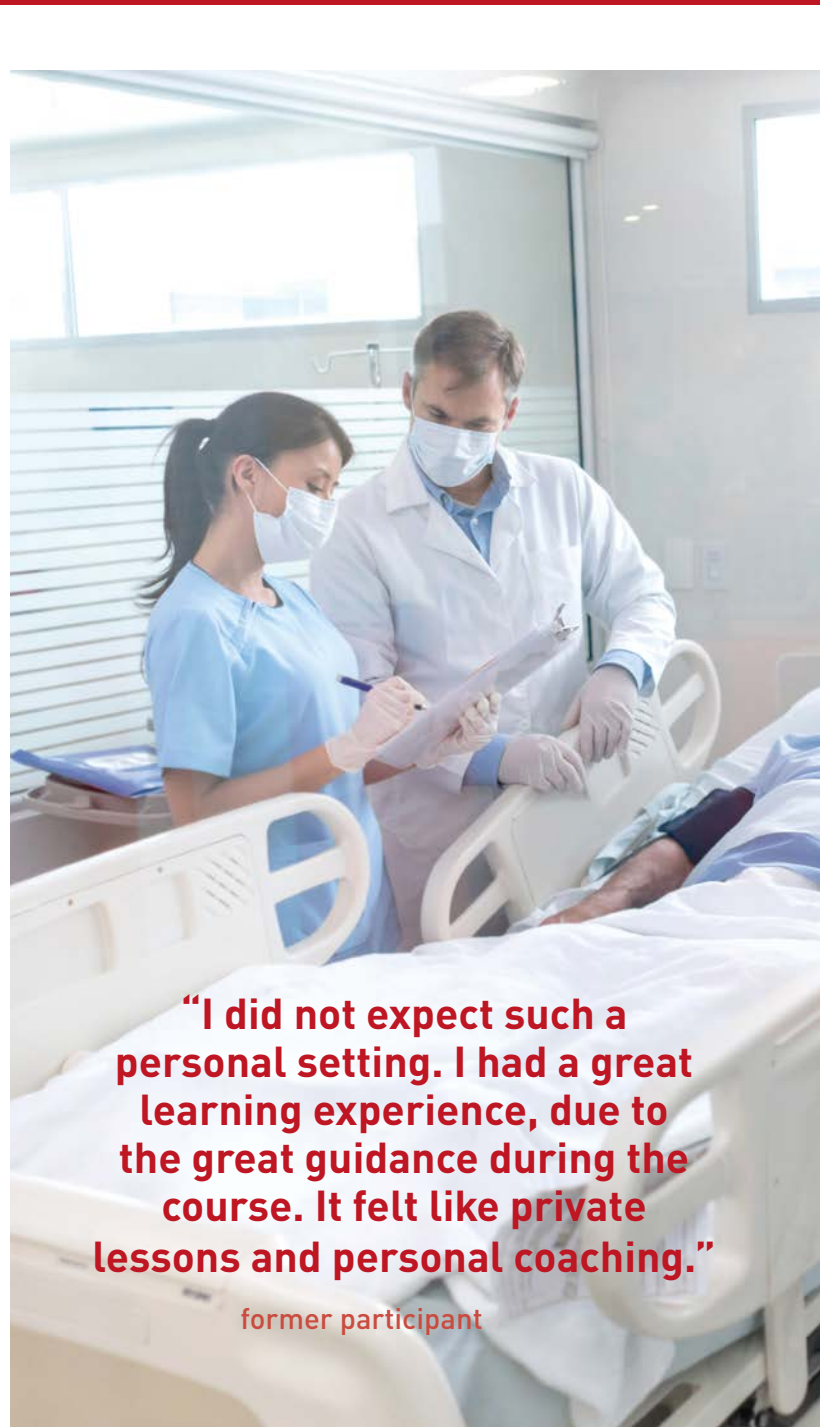
1 Course Description

- for all healthcare professionals who want to develop the knowledge and skills required to run successful simulation scenarios and debriefings.
- It exceeds the expectations of a regular course, because it includes a whole set of educational activities over a longer period of time, which ensures directly applicable, deep and long-lasting learning effects for all participants.
- We focus on the key aspects of healthcare simulation: adult learning, the concept of human factors, the application of crisis resource management (CRM), scenario design, debriefing and feedback skills.

The content is suitable for physicians, nurses and allied healthcare providers in all fields of healthcare, as well as paramedics and pre-hospital personnel. If you are an educator in healthcare or want to start working in that area – this is the right course for you!

The participants will be able to

- Create and deliver effective simulation scenarios
- Provide a safe learning environment
- Provide constructive feedback and debriefing to medical teams including aspects of human factors and crisis resource management (CRM)
- Develop appropriate questioning techniques and styles for debriefings, as well as self-reflective questioning techniques (incl. the “3-Step-Question Technique”)
- Prevent, avoid and manage difficult debriefing situations

3 Course Program

Qualify as a simulation training instructor and facilitator

The course is comprehensive mix of webinars, assignments and individual coaching and feedback, supported by continuous networking webinars for two years following the actual course.

1	Pre-course material and individual 1:1 webinar equipment check	Prior to the course, participants will receive a package with a set of course materials like checklists, cognitive aids, scenario templates etc. We also offer an individual video conference equipment check.
2	Course Part 1: A 2-day initial course as a highly interactive webinar with small group activities and individual feedback on debriefing techniques and practice.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Adult learning principles as they apply to simulation team training · Principles of feedback and debriefing · Causes of errors in medicine and the concept of CRM · Input for scenario design
3	Assignments: To be completed between course part 1 and 2.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · the participants will design a simulation scenario based on a provided template. Feedback to the scenario will be provided by domain experts
4	Course Part 2: Another 2-day course to deepen learning effects and exercise and improve the skills from part 1. Highly interactive, with lots of small group activities and individual feedback.	<p>This course is a booster for the following skills:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Debriefing and constructive question techniques · Avoiding and managing difficult debriefing situations · Scenario design including feedback to own scenarios
5	Individual time with a faculty member: 75 minutes in a 1:1 videoconference.	Every participant will get a 75-minute private 1:1 videoconference with an experienced senior faculty member to discuss open questions, personal projects and/or receive individual feedback on debriefing techniques.
6	“Transfer and Application Refresher”: A half-day interactive webinar with all participants of your course and faculty members.	<p>Two months after Course Part 2. Facilitates the transfer of your new knowledge and skills</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Interactive small group debriefing exercises in groups of 4–6 participants to refresh your skills. · Room for open questions and networking.
7	Individual 1:1 time with a faculty member: 60 Min. of feedback to a submitted personal video of one of your own debriefings in a simulation center.	Every participant will get another 60 minutes of individual 1:1 feedback with an experienced faculty member. You can submit a video of one of your debriefings, but you may also use the time for other questions you might have.
8	“Fine-tuning your instructor skills”: A half day interactive webinar with all participants of your course and faculty members.	<p>Five months after course part 2. Interactive problem-based small group debriefing exercises.</p> <p>Room for open questions and networking between participants as “Instructor Alumni Group” and faculty members</p>
Active networking (2 times per year): A bi-annual half day interactive webinar for course participants of all courses, included for 2 years after starting the course. We plan to continue biannual interactive webinar-based meetings even after 2 years.		<p>Meet the alumni of all courses to build & maintain your international network</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Can serve as “External Quality Assurance” for your simulation program · Debriefing exercises and case discussions · Prevention and management of difficult debriefings · Talks by selected simulation experts incl. Q&A sessions

Price
